

Recommended Precautions for LOBC

All members, guests and friends, including pastoral staff and greeting teams, will work together to maintain physical separation of approximately six feet unless from the same household. Avoid physical contact. Please respect those who wish to refrain from shaking hands

Announcements and signs will be made and posted requesting limited physical contact and listing appropriate physical separation guidelines.

Anyone who has had a recent fever or is not feeling well, should stay home.

All children will have their temperature checked prior to admission to our nursery or any of our childrens' programs.

During church services, anyone displaying cold-like symptoms, including but not limited to coughing, excessive sneezing, or cold chills, should willingly dismiss themselves from the service to ensure the health and welfare of others.

All members, guests and friends should wash their hands regularly. Hand sanitizer bottles/stations are available in the foyer of our sanctuary.

We are Increasing the regular cleaning of our facilities, ensuring that disinfectant is being used in critical areas such as classrooms, kitchen area and bathrooms facilities.

Anyone who has traveled overseas recently should remain home from all services until symptom free for at least fourteen (14) days.

As a Church, we are attempting to record services to make them available to individuals that are unable to attend services due to health concerns.

If you are fearful, elderly, immune compromised, or have a vulnerable pulmonary system, we would encourage you not to attend public services at this time.
