PASTOR’S THOUGHT: John 13:17 – “If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.”

The false belief that happiness could be found in getting just *one more thing* than we have now – a newer car, a bigger house, a larger paycheck, a different spouse, or a better church – has been around since the Garden of Eden. Even in a perfect world with no sin and only ***one restriction***, Adam and Eve still looked on the forbidden fruit with longing and eventually ate it despite God’s command. “*And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.*” (Genesis 3:6)

Lasting happiness is never found in getting what God has decreed to be off limits. Instead, it is found when we willingly submit our will and our desires to His command and obey. Dr. John Rice said, “Sin in the Christian brings the smiting of the conscience. It brings the rebuke of the Holy Spirit.
