**PASTOR'S THOUGHT: John 14:27 – “Peace I leave with you, me peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you, Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”**

For years two monks lived together in concord and harmony. The monotony of their manner of life finally moved one of them to say, “*Let us get out of the groove of our humdrum round of daily tasks and do something different – let's do as the world does.*” Having lived the sequestered style of life so long, the other monk inquired, “*What does the world without do?*” “*Well, for one thing, the world without quarrels.*” Having lived together so long in the bondage of a holy love, he had forgotten how to quarrel, so he asked, “*Just how does the world quarrel?*” so the other monk replied, “*See that stone. Place that stone between us and say, ‘That stone is mine.’*” Willing to accommodate his friend, he said, “*That stone is mine.*” Pausing briefly for a time of reflection and feeling the compulsion of their years of true friendship, the monk who suggested the quarrel concluded, “*Well, brother, the stone is thine, so keep it.*” And thus, the quarrel quickly ended. ....*John R. How suddenly and abruptly we would find our causes for quarrels to subside if we took to heart the lesson taught by these two monks? When our families, friends, co-workers and fellow students mean more to us than a stone (*things*) and we finally learn to prioritize the importance of ***relationships***, both inside and outside of the church, rather than preference and petty things, then we will have accomplished something of great magnitude.

The peace the Jesus gives to His Children is not the kind of peace that always has to be right. Neither is it the kind of peace that always has to have its own way. The kind of peace that Jesus gives is the kind of peace that prizes harmony and unity. Let's evaluate the peace that Jesus has imparted to us and be sure it's the kind of peace that strives toward forgoing quarrels.
