PASTOR'S THOUGHT: II Corinthians 4:3,6 – "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost....For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

A young Jewish boy joined up with the Schoolbag Gospel League , and was so pleased with the Gospel of John that he hurriedly returned to the league's headquarters to get one of the other Gospels. Before leaving, he gave his heart to the Lord and he prayed this simple, heartfelt prayer, "Oh, Lord, I want to know the truth." A little later, he returned to the headquarters with twenty-two cards of other students that had signed up and asked for an additional twenty-two Gospels. When he returned home with the Gospels, his mother asked, "What makes such a large bulk in your pockets?" On his telling her, she took the Gospels and destroyed them all, giving the boy a severe beating, and leaving him with cuts on his forehead and cheek.

What do you think he did? He went out and signed-up two more children, then returned to the league's headquarters for *twenty-four Gospels*. What a missionary this young Jewish boy was?

What would it take for us *hide the Gospel*? The Apostle Paul reminds believers, numbered down through the ages of time, that if the Gospel be hidden, it is hid from those that are lost. **LOST!** This young Jewish boy who prayed to "*know the truth*" is a glaring example of millions walking our planet today – void, empty and destitute of truth.

Let's choose to renew our zeal and enthusiasm for sharing the truth of the Gospel. Just as this young man knew friends that were lost – *without the Gospel of Christ* - we do too. If the Gospel of Christ is hid, may it not be hidden by us!!
