**PASTOR'S THOUGHT: John 11:25 – "Jesus said unto her (Martha), I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."**

Dr. Seamands tells of a Muslim who became a Christian in Africa. "Some of his friends asked him, 'Why have you become a Christian?' He answered, 'Well, it's like this. Suppose you were going down the road and suddenly the road forked in two directions, and you didn't know which way to go, and there at the fork in the road were two men, one dead and one alive-- which one would you ask which way to go?'"

Far too many people have come to that same fork in the road and have chosen to ask the dead man for directions and today the consequences of having chosen such advice has bought them to disappointment, heartache and ruin. Many of these people will smile and pretend that they are happy; yet inside their heart they are miserable, hurting and empty. If this scenario is a pretty accurate description of your life today, let me encourage you to hurry back to the fork in your road and follow the true Giver of Life. He's at the fork in the road and He's waiting still. On this *Resurrection Sunday*, choose life!

Too many times, we search for life's meaning from people who have yet to find it themselves. Be careful of the voices that we give our ears and hearts to. Get serious about listening to that still small inner voice that simply says, *"This is the way....walk in it."* **Easter** is the time to rejoice and to be thankful for the gifts of life, love, and joy; and it is the prayer of this pastor and of this church that you will find these gifts to be yours today.
