PASTOR’S THOUGHT: Mark 11:24 – “Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when you pray, believe that ye receive them. And ye shall have them.”

Houston pastor John Bisango describes a time when his daughter Melodye Jan, age five came to him and asked for a doll house. John promptly nodded and promised to build her one, then he hurriedly went back to reading his book. Soon he glanced out the study window and saw his daughter’s arms filled with dishes, toys, and dolls, making trip after trip until she had a great pile of playthings stacked in the yard. He asked his wife what Melodye Jan was doing.

“Oh, you promised to build her a doll house, and she believes you. She’s just getting things ready for it.” You would have thought I’d been hit by an atom bomb,” John later said. “I threw aside that book, raced down to the lumber yard for supplies, and quickly built my little girl a doll house. Now, why did I respond? Because I wanted to? **No**. Because she deserved it? Again **No**. Her daddy had given his daughter his word, and she believed it and was acting upon it. When I saw my daughter’s faith, **NOTHING** could keep me from carrying out my word.”

Five-year-old Melodye Jan had asked her dad for a doll house, and she followed her request with actions that she believed that her dad would provide the doll house that he had promised. Sometimes, we ask God for things, but we don’t do anything to prepare for the answer to our prayer. As we pray for God to provide our Church with her next pastor, let’s be doing the things that show God that we *really believe* that He will answer our prayers. Because when God sees that we truly believe He will provide what we desire in faith, **NOTHING** will keep Him from honoring His word!
